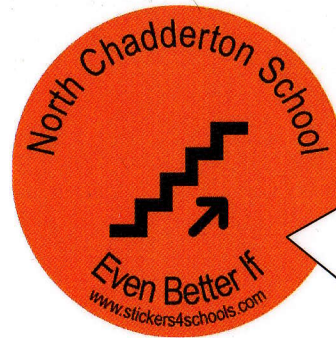


How Should I Mark My Books?

These should be given for comments that improve presentation



Even Better If (EBI)

Within each period of marking there should be a diagnostic target – showing learners how to improve their scientific knowledge and understanding and therefore their grade / level

Codes

V (verbal feedback)
SA (self-assessed)
PA (peer-assessed)
Sp = spelling
P = punctuation
// = new paragraph
^ = something missing
? = unclear



What Are Diagnostic Targets?

As long as there is evidence of a target you can use them in a number of ways.

- Use the Longman learning objectives found on the copy-masters at the start of a unit. These could be stuck in or copied out but must be near to the work the comment is about
- Use APP grids
- Use the 'How Can I Improve my grade' posters as a guide
- Use HSW progression table.

What Went Well (WWW)

Identify success and acknowledge effort. Try to be specific, if you have time to write good work, you have time to write what is good about it
Use stickers and stamps
